



**Chicago Children's Choir
Voice of Chicago
Sliding Scale Fees for 2020-2021**

Chicago Children's Choir is an independent non-profit organization. Operating income comes from individual donations, corporate, foundation and government grants, tuition and concert fees. All singer tuition is subsidized in that the fee covers only a portion of the actual cost of instruction.

The annual fee that your family will pay is based upon your family income, and the cost of the program is subsidized for all Voice of Chicago singers. Early registration tuition discounts are available.

Families with more than one singer in Chicago Children's Choir are eligible for a sibling discount. The oldest child pays the full designated sliding scale amount. All other children will receive 20% off the designated sliding scale amount.

In light of the economic difficulties we know many families are experiencing, we will be offering the below subsidies:

- 10% early bird discount for registration by June 15
- \$25 discount for families that refer a new singer who joins CCC
- 20% sibling discount
- Fundraising credits from past tours can be used toward tuition
- **No risk registration!** Tuition and registration fees are refundable for singers who are not able to join us come September

Discounts will be applied up to full amount of tuition
