Chicago Children's Choir Elects David Koo New Chairman of Board of Directors

Koo has served on the Board of Directors for over six years

CHICAGO— Chicago Children's Choir (CCC) today announced David Koo as the organization's new Chairman of the Board. Koo previously served as Vice Chairman, and has been involved in the organization for over six years. Koo's leadership comes at a critical point for the organization as it closes *Raising Voices*, a major capital campaign to increase programming and opportunities for the nearly 5,000 singers across Chicago enrolled in its program.

"It has been an honor to serve on the Board and witness tremendous organizational growth under Bob Fealy's guidance," said David Koo, Chicago Children's Choir Chairman of the Board. "I'm thrilled for the opportunity to enhance my role and lead CCC on the path to continued success."

Koo assumes the position from outgoing Chairman of the Board, Robert Fealy, who has served as a Board Member for Chicago Children's Choir since 2010.

"David's commitment to service and the performing arts makes him the ideal individual to take over as Chairman of the Board for Chicago Children's Choir," said Fealy. "I know he will continue to lead the board in successfully supporting this wonderful organization."

Founded as a single choir in Hyde Park at the height of the civil rights movement to bridge cultural divides between Chicago's youth, CCC has grown tremendously in scope and programming. The organization now features an in-school program of 112 choirs embedded in 86 Chicago schools, a neighborhood program including 10 community-based choirs, Dimension ensemble for young male voices, and top-performing ensemble, Voice of Chicago.

"I am thrilled to welcome David as the Chairman of the Board and am excited to continue working with him in his new role," said Josephine Lee, President and Artistic Director of Chicago Children's Choir. "David's dedication to our organization is unmatched, and we look forward to the positive impact he will bring as the new Chairman."

Koo graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration in Accountancy from the University of Notre Dame in 1993 and became a Certified Public Account the same year. Prior to assuming his position as Senior Partner at RoundTable Healthcare Partners in 2006, Koo worked at U.S. Health Care Investment Banking Group and KPMG Peat Marwick.

Founded as a single choir in Hyde Park at the height of the Civil Rights Movement in 1956, today Chicago Children's Choir serves more than 4,800 youth who represent all 57 Chicago zip codes. Founder Reverend Christopher Moore believed in using music to unite youth from diverse backgrounds. That simple yet powerful mission has grown exponentially, with programs in 86 city schools, 10 neighborhoods, a choir for boys with changing voices, and the world-renowned Voice of Chicago.
